## Perfect Pets

### Materials List

#### Quilt Top

- 3 coordinating fabrics of 3, 1 yard cuts

#### Backing Fabric

- 3 yards of fabric

#### Other Materials

- Twin-size batting
- Sewing thread to match fabric



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# Perfect Pets

Designed by Donna Robertson

**Finished Size:** 42" x 53"

**Note:** WOF means “width of fabric.” Seam allowance is ¼" throughout. This quilt is intended as an economy quilt designed to utilize 44" wide fabric most efficiently. If you choose to prewash fabrics, overcast raw edges to avoid loss of fabric through raveling. We use a single fold binding. Tutorial available at [fabriccafe.com](http://fabriccafe.com). If double fold binding is preferred, an additional ½ yard of fabric is needed.

## Cutting Instructions

### From Fabric #1:

\* Cut 2, 10½" x WOF; from these strips, cut 6, 10½" x 10½" **Block “A”**

\* Cut 5, 1¼" x WOF for binding

### From Fabric #2:

\* Cut 2, 10½" x WOF; from these strips, cut 6, 10½" x 10½" **Block “B”**

\* Cut 4, 2½" x WOF for border #2

### From Fabric #3:

\* Cut 2, 1½" x WOF; from these strips, cut 8, 1½" x 10½" **Block “C”**

\* Cut 3, 1½" x WOF; from these strips, cut 3, 1½" x 32½" **Sashing strips**

\* Cut 4, 1½" x WOF for border #1

\* Cut 5, 2½" x WOF for border #3

\* Cut 6 **Pet Patterns** of choice from remaining fabric and paper-backed fusible, following manufacturer’s instructions

### From Backing Fabric:

\* Cut 2, 54" x WOF

## Step 1: Block “B” Assembly

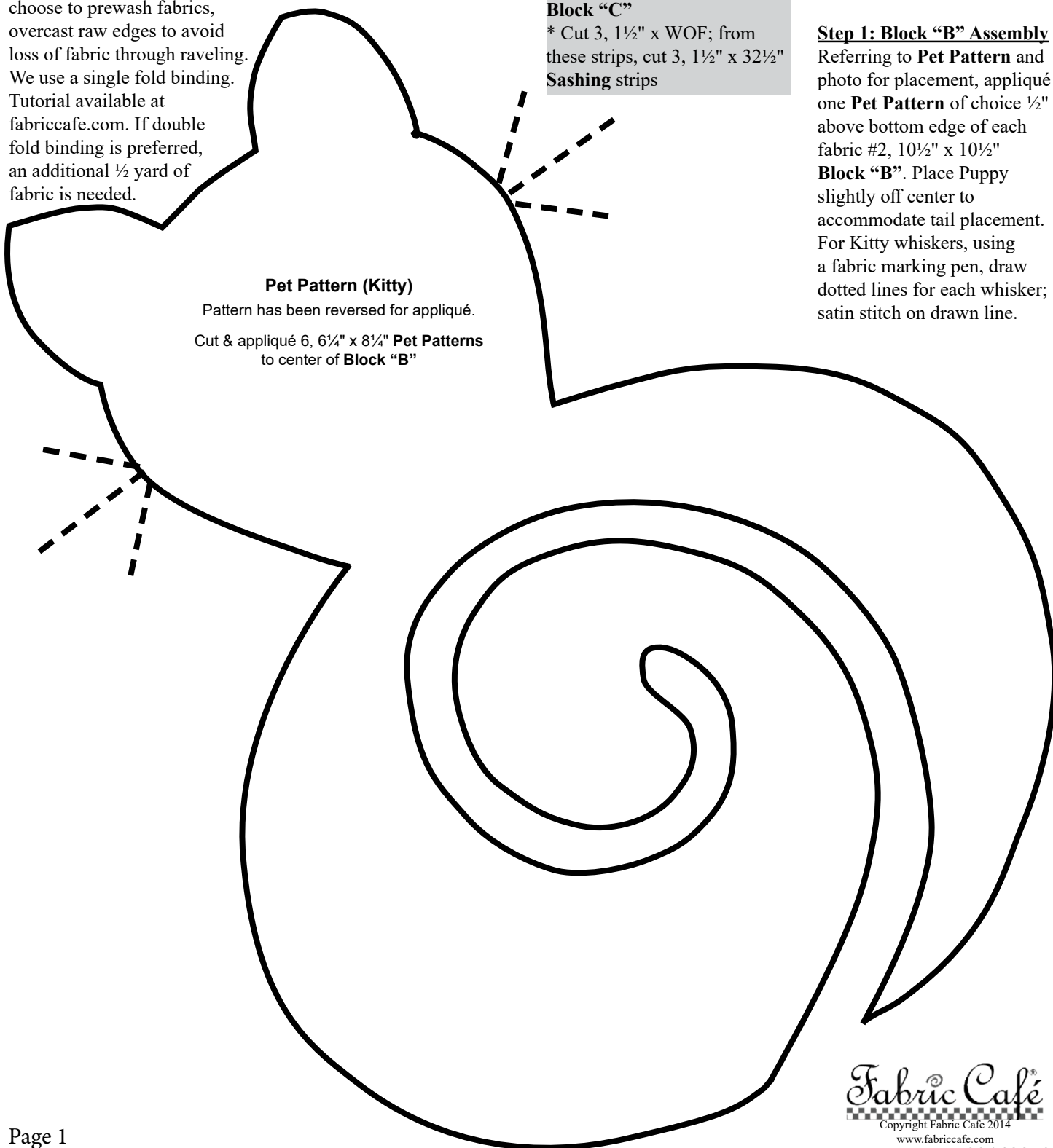
Referring to **Pet Pattern** and photo for placement, appliqué one **Pet Pattern** of choice ½" above bottom edge of each fabric #2, 10½" x 10½"

**Block “B”**. Place Puppy slightly off center to accommodate tail placement. For Kitty whiskers, using a fabric marking pen, draw dotted lines for each whisker; satin stitch on drawn line.

### **Pet Pattern (Kitty)**

Pattern has been reversed for appliqué.

Cut & appliqué 6, 6¼" x 8¼" **Pet Patterns** to center of **Block “B”**



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# Perfect Pets

## Step 2: Row Assembly

Referring to **Row Assembly "A"** diagram, alternating **Blocks "A", "B"** and **"C"** as shown, assemble **Row "A"**. Repeat making 2, 10½" x 32½" **Row "A"**. Referring

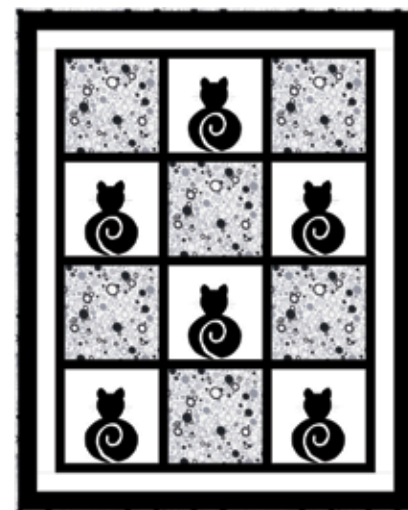
#2, repeat using fabric #2, 2½" x WOF border strips. For border #3, repeat using fabric #3, 2½" x WOF border strips.

## Step 5: Backing and Binding

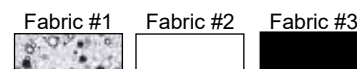
Sew backing fabric together

along trimmed selvage edges; press. Layer top, batting and backing together; quilt as desired. For binding, using fabric #1, 1¼" x WOF binding strips, sew strips together end to end. Press in half with wrong sides together; press one raw edge to center fold. Place right side of binding to front side of quilt. Using a scant ¼", sew unpressed edge of binding to quilt, mitering corners. Fold to back and hand stitch in place.

## Fabric Selection Guide



to **Row Assembly "B"** diagram, alternating **Blocks "A", "B"** and **"C"** as shown, assemble **Row "B"**. Repeat making 2, 10½" x 32½" **Row "B"**.

## Step 3:

### Quilt Assembly

Referring to **Quilt Assembly** diagram, assemble rows and **Sashing** strips as shown.

## Step 4: Borders

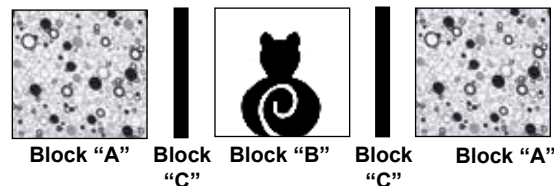
For border #1, using fabric #3, 1½" x WOF border strips, sew together end to end. Sew strip to each side of quilt; trim even with top and bottom. Using remainder of strip, sew to top and bottom; trim even with sides. For border

## Pet Pattern (Puppy)

Pattern has been reversed for appliqué.

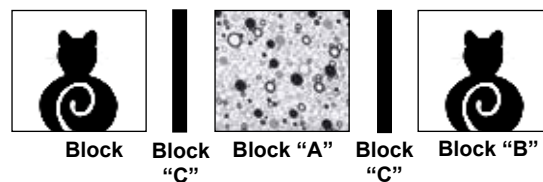
Cut & appliqué 6, 7" x 8¼" **Pet Patterns** to center of **Block "B"**

Make 2, 10½" x 32½" **Row "A"**
