Adding a Border Instructions

Step 1: Measure

Referring to **Measure The Perimeter** diagram, measure each side of quilt; add the four measurements together to determine the perimeter of the quilt.


Step 2: Cut Border Strips

Referring to the **Fabric Chart** below, find the desired width of border, required yardage and the number and size of strips to cut.

Step 3: Assemble Border

For border, using the border strips, sew together end to end. Sew strip to each side of quilt; trim even with top and bottom. Using remainder of strip, sew to top and bottom; trim even with sides.

Quilt Perimeter (total of all four sides of quilt)	Add a 2 Inch Border	Add a 5 Inch Border	Number of Strips	Double Fold Binding
Less than 216"	½ yard	1 yard	Cut 6, 2½" strips	½ yard
216" to 222"	½ yard	1 yard	Cut 6, 5½" strips	½ yard
