

Make A Square Pillow Cover

Step 1: Assemble Block

Referring to quilt pattern of choice, make one block.



Step 2: Cut Border Strips

Referring to the pattern, cut one border strip for each border. Following the border instructions, sew border(s) to block. To increase the size of the pillow cover, continue adding border strips.




Step 3: Make Backing

Measure pillow top. Referring to the chart below, cut 2 backing pieces for that measurement. Using one pillow backing, press one long edge under ¼". Press same edge under an additional ¼"; topstitch in place. Repeat for second backing piece.



Step 4: Assemble Pillow Cover

Overlap finished edges of backing pieces to total pillow top size; machine baste backing pieces together. With right sides together, sew pillow front to backing. Clip corners; turn and press.

12½" x 12½"	Cut 2, 8½" x 12½"	14" x 14"
13½" x 13½"	Cut 2, 9" x 13½"	15" x 15"
14½" x 14½"	Cut 2, 9½" x 14½"	16" x 16"
15½" x 15½"	Cut 2, 10" x 15½"	17" x 17"
16½" x 16½"	Cut 2, 10½" x 16½"	18" x 18"
17½" x 17½"	Cut 2, 11" x 17½"	19" x 19"
18½" x 18½"	Cut 2, 11½" x 18½"	20" x 20"
19½" x 19½"	Cut 2, 12" x 19½"	21" x 21"
20½" x 20½"	Cut 2, 12½" x 20½"	22" x 22"

*Pillow Top and Backing Size includes seam allowance
