An exclusive pattern for the *Aurora Flurries* collection by Blank Quilting


Notes: WOF means "width of fabric". Seam allowance is $\frac{1}{4}$ " throughout. If you choose to prewash fabrics, overcast raw edges to avoid loss of fabric through raveling. This pattern uses a single-fold binding. Tutorial available at FabricCafe.com. If a double-fold binding is preferred, an additional $\frac{1}{2}$ yard of fabric is needed.



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Cutting Tips:

Before cutting fabric, label each fabric with its fabric number to avoid miscuts. Follow the **Cutting Instructions** in the order given; as each cut is made, place the cut fabric in a zip-close bag. Using a permanent marker, write the measurement, fabric number and name of piece on the bag (i.e. border, binding, blocks, etc.).


From Fabric #1:

* Cut 8, 3½" x WOF for **Strip Assembly**



From Fabric #8:

* Cut 1, 9½" x WOF; from this strip, cut 2, 9½" x 9½" squares for **Block "D"**




From Fabric #2:

* Cut 8, 2" x WOF for **Strip Assembly**
* Cut 2, 2" x WOF; from these strips, cut 40, 2" x 2" squares for **Unit "A" Assembly**
* Cut 4, 2" x WOF; from these strips, cut 40, 2" x 3½" rectangles for **Unit "B" Assembly**



From Fabric #9:

* Cut 1, 9½" x WOF; from this strip, cut 3, 9½" x 9½" squares for **Block "E"**



From Fabric #3:

* Cut 8, 2" x WOF for **Strip Assembly**
* Cut 2, 2" x WOF; from these strips, cut 40, 2" x 2" squares for **Unit "D" Assembly**
* Cut 4, 2" x WOF; from these strips, cut 40, 2" x 3½" rectangles for **Unit "E" Assembly**




From Fabric #10:

* Cut 1, 9½" x WOF; from this strip, cut 2, 9½" x 9½" squares for **Block "F"**



From Fabric #11:

* Cut 1, 9½" x WOF; from this strip, cut 3, 9½" x 9½" squares for **Block "G"**



From Fabric #4:

* Cut 4, 2" x WOF; from these strips, cut 40, 2" x 3½" rectangles for **Unit "A" Assembly**



From Fabric #12:

* Cut 1, 9½" x WOF; from this strip, cut 2, 9½" x 9½" squares for **Block "H"**



From Fabric #5:

* Cut 4, 2" x WOF; from these strips, cut 40, 2" x 3½" rectangles for **Unit "D" Assembly**



From Fabric #13:

* Cut 7, 3" x WOF for border #1



From Fabric #6:

* Cut 2, 2" x WOF; from these strips, cut 40, 2" x 2" squares for **Unit "B" Assembly**
* Cut 4, 2½" x WOF for border #2



From Fabric #14:

* Cut 8, 1¼" x WOF for binding



From Fabric #7:

* Cut 2, 2" x WOF; from these strips, cut 40, 2" x 2" squares for **Unit "E" Assembly**
* Cut 4, 2½" x WOF for border #2

From Backing Fabric:

* Cut 2, 90" x WOF

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
Step 1: Unit "A" & "B" Assembly

Referring to **Unit "A" Assembly**, **Step 1** diagram, using a fabric marking pen, draw a line diagonally from corner to corner on wrong side of 40 fabric #2, 2" x 2" squares. Using one each of fabric #2, 2" x 2" square and fabric #4, 2" x 3½" rectangle for each **Unit "A" Assembly**, place right sides together as shown. Sew on drawn line.


Referring to **Step 2** diagram, trim ¼" from stitch line; press and square block to 2" x 3½". Repeat making 40, 2" x 3½" **Unit "A"**.

Referring to **Unit "B" Assembly** diagrams, repeat using fabric #2, 2" x 3½" rectangles and fabric #6, 2" x 2" squares. Repeat making 40, 2" x 3½" **Unit "B"**.


Unit "B" Assembly



Step 2: Unit "C" Assembly

Referring to **Unit "C" Assembly** diagram, using one **Unit "A"** and one **Unit "B"**, rotating as shown, sew together. Repeat making 40, 3½" x 3½" **Unit "C"**.

Unit "C" Assembly




Step 3: Block "A" Assembly

Referring to **Block "A" Assembly**, **Step 1** diagram, using 2 **Unit "C"**, rotating one as shown, sew together. Repeat making 20, 3½" x 6½" **Step 1**.

Referring to **Step 2** diagram, using 2 **Step 1**, rotating one as shown, sew together. Repeat making 10, 6½" x 6½" **Block "A"**.

Block "A" Assembly




Step 4: Unit "D" & "E" Assembly

Referring to **Unit "D" Assembly**, **Step 1** diagram, using a fabric marking pen, draw a line diagonally from corner to corner on wrong side of 40 fabric #3, 2" x 2" squares. Using one each of fabric #3, 2" x 2" square and fabric #5, 2" x 3½" rectangle for each **Unit "D" Assembly**, place right sides together as shown. Sew on drawn line.

Referring to **Step 2** diagram, trim ¼" from stitch line; press and square block to 2" x 3½". Repeat making 40, 2" x 3½" **Unit "D"**.


Referring to **Unit "E" Assembly** diagrams, repeat using fabric #3, 2" x 3½" rectangles and fabric #7, 2" x 2" squares. Repeat making 40, 2" x 3½" **Unit "E"**.

Unit "D" Assembly




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Step 7: Block "C" Assembly


Referring to **Strip Assembly** diagram, using one fabric #1, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip, one fabric #2, 2" x WOF strip, and one fabric #3, 2" x WOF strip, sew together on long edges as shown. Repeat making 8 assemblies. Cut into 31, 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Block "C".



Make 8 assemblies. Cut into 31, 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " **Block "C"**

Step 5: Unit "F" Assembly

Referring to **Unit "F" Assembly** diagram, using one **Unit "D"** and one **Unit "E"**, rotating as shown, sew together. Repeat making 40, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " **Unit "F"**.




Step 6: Block "B" Assembly

Referring to **Block "B" Assembly, Step 1** diagram, using 2 **Unit "F"**, rotating one as shown, sew together. Repeat making 20, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " **Step 1**.

Referring to **Step 2** diagram, using 2 **Step 1**, rotating one as shown, sew together. Repeat making 10, 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " **Block "B"**.

Step 8: Quilt Assembly

Referring to **Row "A" Assembly** diagram, using 2 **Block "A"**, 2 **Block "B"**, and 3 **Block "C"**, rotating as shown, assemble 3, 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 51 $\frac{1}{2}$ " **Row "A"**.

Referring to **Row "B" Assembly** diagram, using 4 **Block "C"**, rotating as shown, one **Block "D"**, one **Block "E"**, and one **Block "F"**, assemble one, 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 51 $\frac{1}{2}$ " **Row "B"**.

Referring to **Row "C" Assembly** diagram, using 2 **Block "A"**, 2 **Block "B"**, and 3 **Block "C"**, rotating as shown, assemble 2, 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 51 $\frac{1}{2}$ " **Row "C"**.

Referring to **Row "D" Assembly** diagram, using 4 **Block "C"**, rotating as shown, one **Block "G"**, one **Block "H"**, and one **Block "E"**, assemble one, 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 51 $\frac{1}{2}$ " **Row "D"**.







Referring to **Row "E" Assembly** diagram, using 4 **Block "C"**, rotating as shown, one **Block "D"**, one **Block "F"**, and one **Block "G"**, assemble one, 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 51 $\frac{1}{2}$ " **Row "E"**.

Referring to **Row "F" Assembly** diagram, using 4 **Block "C"**, rotating as shown, one **Block "E"**, one **Block "G"**, and one **Block "H"**, assemble one, 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 51 $\frac{1}{2}$ " **Row "F"**.

Referring to **Quilt Assembly** diagram, alternating **Rows** as shown, assemble 9 Rows.

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Step 9: Borders

For border #1, using fabric #13, 3" x WOF border strips, sew together end to end. Sew strip to each side of quilt; trim even with top and bottom. Using remainder of strip, sew to top and bottom; trim even with sides.

For border #2, using fabric #7, 2½" x WOF border strips, sew together end to end. Sew strip to right side of quilt; trim even with top and bottom. Set remainder of strip aside. Using fabric #6, 2½" x WOF border strips, sew together end to end. Sew strip to left side of quilt; trim even with top and bottom. Sew remainder of strip to top; trim even with sides. Using remainder of fabric #7 strip, sew to bottom; trim even with sides.

Step 10: Backing & Binding

Sew backing fabric together along trimmed selvage edges; press. Layer top, batting and backing together; quilt as desired. For binding, using fabric #14, 1¼" x WOF binding strips, sew strips together end to end. Press in half with wrong sides together; press one raw edge to center fold. Place right side of binding to front side of quilt. Using a scant ¼", sew unpressed edge of binding to quilt, mitering corners. Fold to back and hand stitch in place.
