

### **Materials List**

### **Quilt Top**

 3 coordinating fabrics of 3, 1 yard cuts

### **Backing Fabric**

· 3 yards of fabric


### **Other Materials**

- · Twin-size batting
- Sewing thread to match fabric

This is an economy quilt designed to efficiently utilize 44" wide fabric. A single fold binding is used. An additional ½ yard of fabric is needed for a double fold binding. Binding Tutorial available at fabriccafe.com. WOF means "width of fabric".

### **Pretty Please**

Designed by Donna Robertson **Finished Size** 44½" x 59½"

Note: WOF means "width of fabric." Seam allowance is ½" throughout. This quilt is intended as an economy quilt designed to utilize 44" wide fabric most efficiently. If you choose to prewash fabrics, overcast raw edges to avoid loss of fabric through raveling. We use a single fold binding. Tutorial available at fabriccafe.com. If double fold binding is preferred, an additional ½ yard of fabric is needed.

### Cutting Instructions From Fabric #1:

\* Cut 3, 8" x WOF; from these strips, cut 15, 8" x 8" **Block "B"** 

\* Cut 1, 8" x WOF; from this strip, cut 3, 8" x 8" **Block "B"**; from remainder of this strip, cut 4, 4" x 4" corner blocks

### From Fabric #2:

\* Cut 4, 2½" x WOF for

\* Cut 7, 2½" x WOF for

### Block "A" Assembly From Fabric #3:

\* Cut 2, 4" x WOF for **Strip Assembly** 

\* Cut 4, 4" x WOF for border

\* Cut 1, 4" x WOF; from this strip, cut 1, 4" x 31" for

**Border Extension**. From remainder of this strip, cut 1, 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 10" **Binding** 

#### Extension

\* Cut 5, 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x WOF for binding

### From Backing Fabric:

\* Cut 2, 54" x WOF

### Step 1: Block "A" Assembly

Referring to Strip Assembly

diagram, using 2 fabric #2, 2½" x WOF strips and one fabric #3, 4" x WOF strip, sew together on long edges; repeat making 2 assemblies. Cut into 17, 4" x 8" **Unit** "A". Referring to **Block** "A" Assembly diagram, using one **Unit** "A" and one fabric #2, 2½" x WOF strip, sew strip to one side; trim even with top and bottom. Repeat on second side. Repeat making 17, 8" x 8" **Block** "A".

### **Step 2: Quilt Assembly**

Referring to **Quilt Assembly** diagram, alternating **Blocks** "A" and "B" as shown, assemble 7 rows of 5 blocks each.


### Step 3: Border

For border, measure across the top of quilt; using 2 fabric #3, 4" x WOF border strips, cut this measurement from each strip. Sew one corner block to each end of these strips. Set these strips aside. Using remaining 2 border strips and Border Extension, sew together end to end. Sew strip to each side of quilt; trim even with top and bottom. Sew one border strip with corner blocks to each top and bottom.


### **Step 4: Backing & Binding**


Sew backing fabric together along trimmed selvage edges; press. Layer top, batting and backing together; quilt as desired. For binding, using fabric #3, 11/4" x WOF binding strips and **Binding Extension**, sew

### **Quilt Assembly**




#### **Fabric Selection Guide**






### **Block "A" Assembly**



strips together end to end. Press in half with wrong sides together; press one raw edge to center fold. Place right side of binding to front side of quilt. Using a scant ½" sew unpressed edge of binding to quilt,



Make 17, 8" x 8" Block "A"

mitering corners. Fold to back and hand stitch in place.



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
