

# It's A Snap Q/K

Finished Size: 112" x 103"

Fabric	Yardage
3 coordinating fabrics	4 yds. each of 3 fabrics
Backing fabric	9 yds.
Other Materials	
Twin-size cotton batting	
Sewing thread to match fabric	

**Note:** WOF means “width of fabric.” Seam allowance is  $\frac{1}{4}$ " throughout. This quilt is intended as an economy quilt designed to utilize 44" wide fabric most efficiently. If prewashing fabrics, overcast raw edges to avoid loss of fabric through raveling. We use a single fold economy binding. Watch a tutorial at [www.fabriccafe.com](http://www.fabriccafe.com). If double fold binding is preferred, an additional  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard of fabric is needed.

## Cutting Instructions

### From Fabric #1

\* Cut 5, 5" x WOF for **Strip Assembly "A"**

\* Cut 9, 5" x WOF; from these strips cut 36, 5" x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips for **Block "A"**

### Assembly

\* Cut 2, 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF; from these strips cut 8, 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for **Block "D"**.

\* Cut 1, 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF; from this strip cut 1, 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for **Block "D"**. From the remainder of this strip, cut 1, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 15" for **Border #3 Extension**

### Extension

\* Cut 10, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for border #3

### From Fabric #2:

\* Cut 9, 5" x WOF for **Strip Assembly "B"**

\* Cut 4, 5" x WOF; from

these strips cut 16, 5" x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips for **Block "B"**

### Assembly

\* Cut 1, 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF; from this strip cut 1, 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square for **Block "E"**.

\* Cut 9, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for border #1

### From Fabric #3:

\* Cut 14, 5" x WOF for **Strip Assembly "A" and "B"**

\* Cut 9, 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for border #2

\* Cut 1, 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF from this strip cut 1, 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22" for **Border #2 Extension**. From the remainder of this strip, cut 1, 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 20" for **Binding Extension**

\* Cut 10, 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF for binding

### From Backing Fabric:

\* Cut 3, 108" x WOF

### Step 1: Strip Assembly "A"

Referring to **Strip Assembly "A"** diagram, using one fabric #1, 5" x WOF strip and one fabric #3, 5" x WOF strip, sew together on long edges. Repeat making 5 assemblies. Cut 36, 5" x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " **Unit "A"**.

### Step 2: Strip Assembly "B"

Referring to **Strip Assembly "B"** diagram, using one fabric #2, 5" x WOF strip and one fabric #3, 5" x WOF strip, sew together on long edges;

repeat making 9 assemblies. Cut 72, 5" x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " **Unit "B"**.

### Step 3: Block Assembly

Referring to **Block Assembly** diagram, using one fabric #1, 5" x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip, sew to long edge of one **Unit "A"**. Repeat making 36 **Block "A"**. Using one fabric #2, 5" x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip, sew to long edge of one **Unit "B"**. Repeat making 16 **Block "B"**. Using 2 **Unit "B"**, rotating as shown, sew long edges together. Repeat making 28 **Block "C"**.

### Step 4: Quilt Assembly

Referring to **Row Assembly** diagram, rotating **Block "B"** as shown, sew blocks together. Make 9 rows of 10 blocks each. Referring to **Quilt Assembly Diagram**, sew rows together.

### Step 5: Borders

For border #1, using fabric #2 border strips, sew together end to end. Sew strip to each side of quilt; trim even with top and bottom. Sew to top

and bottom; trim even with sides. Repeat using border #2 strips; repeat using border #3 strips and **Border #3 Extension**.

### Step 6: Backing

Sew backing fabric together along trimmed selvage edges; press. Layer top, batting and backing together; quilt as desired.

### Step 7: Binding

For binding, using fabric #3, 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF binding strips and **Binding Extension**, sew strips together end to end. Press in half with wrong sides together; press one raw edge to center fold. With right sides together, using a scant  $\frac{1}{4}$ ", sew unpressed edge of binding to quilt, mitering corners. Fold to back and hand stitch in place.

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## Strip Assembly "A"

(Make 5 assemblies)  
Cut 36, 5" x 9 1/2" Unit "A"



## Strip Assembly "B"

(Make 9 assemblies)  
Cut 72, 5" x 9 1/2" Unit "B"



## Block Assembly

Block "A" Block "B" Block "C"



Sew fabric #1, 5" x 9 1/2" strips to Unit "A" together (Make 28, 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" Block "A")  
Sew fabric #2, 5" x 9 1/2" strips to Unit "B" together (Make 28, 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" Block "B")  
Sew 2 Unit "B" together (Make 28, 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" Block "C")

## Row Assembly

(Make 9 rows of 10 blocks each)
